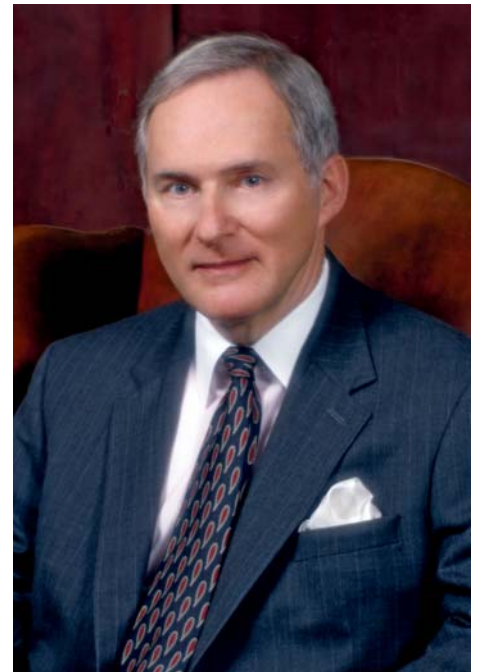
Virginia's Yankee Generals

With Dr. Charles Bryan, Jr.

Virginia supplied more generals to the Confederate army than any other state--90 in all. Almost one-fourth of all Confederate generals came from the Old Dominion. Ironically, Virginia provided more generals to the Union army than any other southern state and more than six northern states. Eighteen native sons of Virginia served as generals in the uniform of blue and under the stars and stripes. Who were these men and why did they not join the majority of their fellow Virginians in siding with the Confederacy? Dr. Charles Faulkner Bryan, Jr., president and CEO of the Virginia Historical Society for the last twenty years, will discuss these unique soldiers who went against the grain, giving particularly emphasis to some of the most interesting generals of the group.
